Sculpture Collection

Throughout VanDusen Botanical Garden you will see the artistry of several local and international artists.

Eleven pieces of stone sculpture were created on site during the summer of 1975 at the International Stone Sculpture Symposium. For two months that summer, the sculptors arrived each morning, working through the day into the early evening to transform large pieces of Turkish marble and travertine into works of art. The raw stone arrived in Vancouver as ballast in returning ships and was donated to the Symposium by Debro Products of Vancouver.
